An Act to amend certain Written Laws

[.....]

ENACTED by the Parliament of the United Republic of Tanzania.

1. This Act may be cited as the Written Laws (Miscellaneous Amendments) Act, 1985.

2. The laws specified in the first and second columns of the Schedule Agreement to this Act are amended in the manner specified in the third column of of certain laws the Schedule.

Acts, 1982 No. 7	The Local Government (District Authorities) Act, 1982	The Local Government (District Authorities) Act, 1982 is amended— (a) in section 31 by deleting sub-sections (2) and (3) and replacing with the following new sub-section:— “(2) Every Ward Committee shall consist of— (a) the Ward Secretary; (b) the elected member of the District Council representing the ward; (c) public officers seconded to the ward; (d) the chairmen of all village councils within the ward; (e) the chief executive officers of all village councils within the ward; (f) all village managers, if any, within the ward. (3) There shall be a Chairman and a Vice-Chairman, both of whom shall be elected by the members from amongst specified in paragraph (b) and (d) of sub-section (2). (4) The Ward Secretary shall be the Secretary and chief executive officer of the ward committee.”; (b) in section 196 by— (i) renumbering that section as “196 (1)”; (ii) by adding immediately after sub-section (1) as amended the following new sub-section—
Acts, 1975 No. 2		“(2) Notwithstanding the repeal of the Villages and Ujamaa Villages (Registration, Designation and Administration) Act, 1975 all Villages and Ujamaa Villages established under that Act shall be deemed to have been established under this Act.
Acts, 1982 No. 8	Local Government (Urban Authorities) Act, 1982	The Local Government (Urban Authorities) Act, 1982 is amended in section 10 by adding immediately after sub-section (3) of that Section the following new sub-section:— (4) Where in the exercise of the powers conferred to the Minister under sub-section (1) The Minister varies the boundaries of an urban area so as to include an area which is a village or an Ujamaa Village registered under the Villages and Ujamaa Village (Registration, Designation and Administration) Act, 1975 that village or Ujamaa Village as the case may be shall continue to exist until the Minister cancels its registration.”.

Local Government Finance

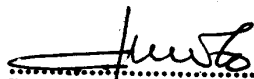
The Local Government Finances Act, 1982 is hereby amended in sub-section (1) of section 41 by—

(a) by deleting the full-stop which appears at the end of that sub-section and substituting for it a semicolon

(b) by adding to that sub-section the following proviso:—

"Provided that the Minister may, by an order published in the *Gazette*, vary the commencement of the financial year of any or all Local Government Authorities."
